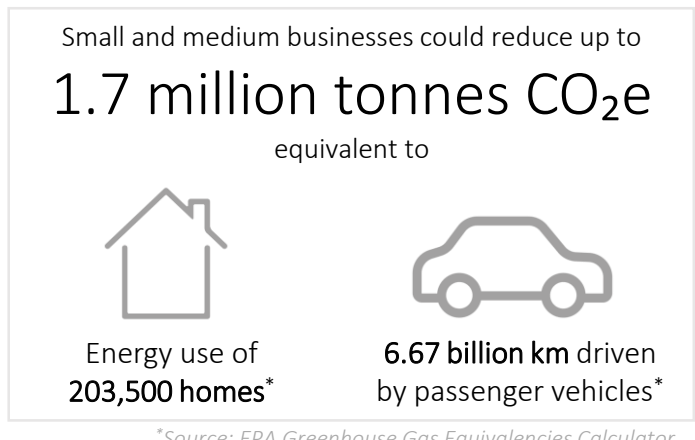
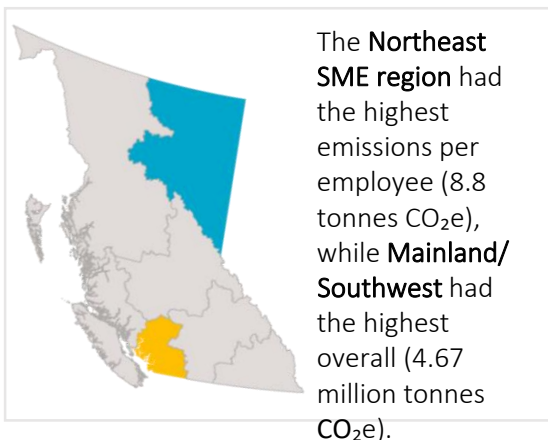
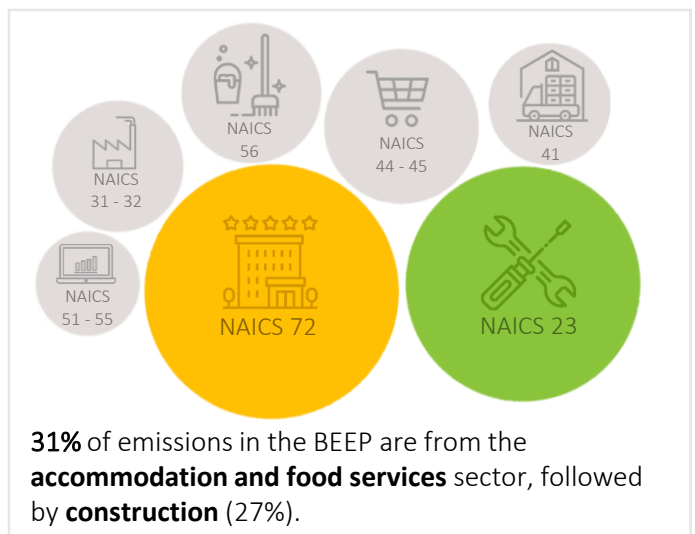
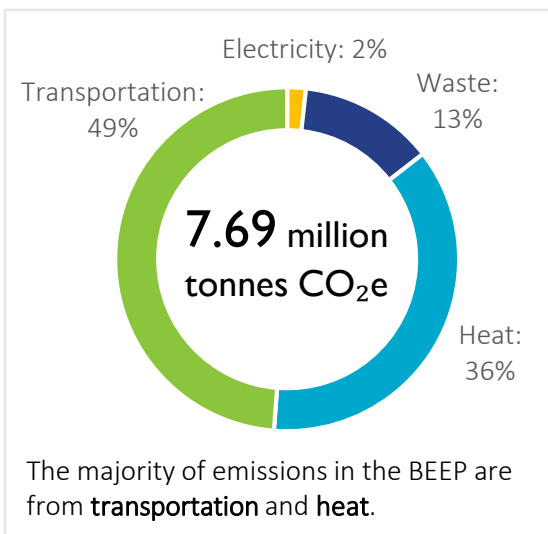
Business data for the clean economy

A Business Energy and Emissions Profile (BEEP) is an analysis of the greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions produced and energy consumed by a business community, in particular its small and medium-sized businesses (SMEs: businesses with 500 employees or less). This first ever provincial BEEP, for British Columbia, provides a unique view of the business sector emissions by industry for SMEs, and highlights the areas with greatest potential for achieving reductions.

Small and medium businesses in British Columbia emit an estimated

7.69 million tonnes CO₂e annually

equivalent to a passenger car driving 30.3 billion km.*
